2010 SPRING SESSION COED RULES AND REGULATIONS (SUBJECT TO CHANGE)

1. RINGER POLICY- Ringers can only score when their team is down by more than one goal. Ringers are not allowed to tie or score lead changing goals.
2. **New- Any player joining this division that has played or has a skill level of our Copper AA will be considered a Ringer player until voted otherwise.**
3. **New- Ringers will have to wear something to make themselves more identifiable to others on the surface. Pull over's etc.**
4. Ringers must play in Defense
5. Those labeled as Ringer women will not be allowed to sub for others during the season.
6. **New- Ringer women will be allowed to sub for each other ONLY!!**
7. Teams will have a list of women that will be allowed to sub
8. One Ringer player limit per team has been removed, although we suggest a limit of one.
9. Ringers must pass the puck before the red line. The play will be whistled dead if a Ringer skates end to end over the red line.
10. **New- Ringer players cannot pass to each other over the red line; this will result in a neutral zone face off.**
11. No Offside's Rule
12. Icing Rule has been reinstated.
13. League will be played 5 on 5 with one woman on the rink at all times. * As we grow the division we will hope to have two women out on the surface at all times as we get more into the league.
14. No Slap shots from any male hockey player may be taken during games. Violations of this rule will lead to a face off in the neutral zone.
15. **New- Penalty in Minutes markers lowered for this division. In all other leagues PIM markers are 36-45-54; in Co-ed this marker has been lowered to 20-25-30. All those who go over 20 pim will receive a one game suspension, 25 two game suspension, 30 minutes will result in removal from division for rest of the season.**
16. **Shootouts- During playoffs shootouts will be 5 players a side 2 women and 3 men must take the first five shots. In the case of your team having only one woman that game, she must take two shots. In the scenario that the shootout goes more than 5 players a side you must go through your entire roster excluding ringers. Once going through the whole team the shootout starts all over as far as player order but it must start out 2 women and 3 men.**

SOME COED LEAGUE SPECIFICS (RULE CLARIFICATIONS)

1. Women can only sub on teams for other women. Teams will not be allowed to sub in women for men. To avoid any unfair advantages with substitute players this will be effective immediately.
2. You may not exceed the amount of women players on your paid roster. This means you may not add additional women to your lineup just to have extra players for a certain game.
3. Several women players have been deemed as Ringer women. These women are excluded from other Ringer rules but have their own separate rule regarding subbing for teams during playoffs. During playoffs Kayla Briers, Jenny Cruz, Trisha Minahan, and Tomo Nakamura may not be used as substitutes.
4. Players, both men and women alike, will not be allowed to play during playoffs unless they are paid/registered league players. Those teams who are caught using unregistered league players will receive a forfeiture of game.
5. If any team is in need of a sub, or would like to get clarification on a sub rule please contact the main hockey office via phone or email. Substitutes must be cleared by the hockey office 24 hours before game time.
6. Any Ringer that is awarded a penalty shot (and is not down by more than 1 goal) will have to designate a player of his own choosing to take that shot. The player chosen must not be a ringer player.
7. **Ringers may not shoot in any shootout situation *including playoffs.**

*note unregistered subs will not be allowed to fill in for teams unless they are cleared by both Hockey Dept. managers prior to the midpoint of the season.
